MARABU CHARCOAL

DATA SHEET

DESCRIPTION-

This charcoal is made from the branches and stems of an invasive plant called in spanish: Marabu. This bush was imported to the Caribbean region in the 19th century. The plant grows rapidly, and reaches a height of up to ten meters.

Uniform black color

Free of dust, cisco or other foreign matter that may affect the quality of the product.

When turned on, it should not spark or explode.

USES-

This product can be used for Domestic and/ or Gastronomic purposes. Solid Fuel for conventional ovens, roasts, barbecues and grills.

QUALITY STANDARS-

Tree Species: Marabu weed.

Preparation: traditional or metal ovens.

Physical-chemical characteristics:

- Calorific value: Not less than 7400 Kcal / Kg
- Maximum Humidity allowed: 6%
- Fixed Carbon: 86-90%
- Abrasive: 68%.
- Ash: 4,5%.
- Volatile: 5-8%.
- Glow Time: 4-5 hours.
- Color: black, uniform.
- Sound: Metallic, no sparks or explode, burn smokeless flame.
- Approximate dimensions:
- Length: up to 20 cm (not less than 4 cm).
- Thickness: up to 5-6 cm (not less than 2 cm).

OTHER CHARACTERISTICS-

Packaging: Polypropylene bags or Paper bags of 15kg or 20 kgs, conveniently sealed by hand or machine stitched.

Manually processed through sieves or packaging machines.

Exported in 40 HQ containers without pallets with no less than 18.5 tons.

Free of dust, cisco, dust or other strange materials.

Coal when ignited, does neither spark nor explode.

STORAGE -

Store between 5 and 40 ° C, away from direct sunlight. Keep away from sources of heat or sparks in the original packaging, properly covered.
